

Propane Safety Information

- **WARNING:** Propane is extremely flammable.
- Propane vapor reduces oxygen available for breathing and may cause suffocation in confined spaces.
- Liquid propane may cause freeze burn similar to frostbite.
- Propane sold for fuel contains a foul smelling, skunk-like warning agent (odorant).
- Do not smoke near or while transporting a propane tank.
- Keep container valve closed and use safety plug when tank is not in use.
- Transport cylinders in an upright position only. Do not lay tank on its side. This can cause leakage.
- Do not leave propane cylinders in car or trunk for any extended length of time.
- Do not use cylinders inside your home or in any enclosed area.
- Cylinders which contain leaks, bad dents, corroded areas or other possible weaknesses will not be refilled until properly repaired and requalified as prescribed by D.O.T. regulations.
